THE FUNDRAISING CO-ORDINATOR!



THIS POSITION SHOULD
BE FILLED BY A TEACHER
OR A STUDENT, OR A
TEAM OF BOTH.



The job of the fundraising co-ordinator is to:

- Decide who should be on the special team of 'fundraising friends' (we'll hear more about them later!).
- Decide what the fundraising activity should be!
- If the fundraising activity involves selling something like lollies or cakes they decide where the best place is for this activity to take place. Is it in the halla? Or maybe outside in the sunshine?
- If the fundraising activity is NOT taking place in school they decide where the activity should take place! (See note on pg4 if activity is not taking place in school).
- # If the activity includes selling, the co-ordinator sets the price!
- Talk to teachers/students about how best to advertise the activity.
- Assign tasks to the 'fundraising friends' team during the day of the activity.
- ★ With the help of a teacher or adult count up all the money collected!

To do their job the fundraising co-ordinator will need the following things: a pencil and paper to write down and tick off all their jobs; name tags for the 'fundraising friends' team so people at the activity will know who they are; a calendar so they can pick a date for the activity and count how many days they have left to organise everything!







This team works with the fundraising co-ordinator to carry out all the busy and important jobs that will need to be done on the day of the activity or during the days and weeks whilst the activity it being planned!

If the activity is being held in your school the team of fundraising friends will:

- Make sure every class knows what's going on and knows where the activity is taking place.
- Make sure that all visitors to the school who are taking part in the activity know that there is someone there who can answer their questions about the activity or show them where to go!
- Do lots of running around making sure that the fundraising co-ordinator has all the help they need!!

If the activity is NOT being held in your school the fundraising friends will:

- Make sure every class knows what's going on and knows where the activity is taking place.
- Do lots of running around making sure that the fundraising co-ordinator has all the help they need to prepare the activity!!

## ADVERTISING YOUR ACTIVITY!


#### Great job so far!!


